

Sharing the Gospel

Open your Bible to the first verse. Give your Bible to the person. Have him read the verse out loud, or you read it as he follows along. After each verse, ask "What is this saying?" Then go on to the next verse, and repeat.

Genesis 1:1 — Have them read it out loud.
"What does this say to you?" God created everything.

Psalms 16:11 — Explain that the writer is talking to God.
Have them read it out loud. "What does this say to you?"
Full and lasting joy is found in God's presence.

Jeremiah 2:12-13 — Have them read it out loud.
"What does this say to you?" We have all turned from God.

Romans 1:18-21 — Have them read it out loud.
"What do these verses say to you?"
God's wrath is against us because we have turned from Him.

1 Peter 3:18 — Have them read it out loud.
"What does this verse say to you?"
Jesus died for our sins, to bring us to God.

Acts 3:19 — Have them read it out loud.
"What does this verse say to you?"
If I repent, my sins will be blotted out.

John 7:37-38 — Have them read it out loud.
"What does this verse say to you?"
If I believe in Jesus, He will satisfy my thirst with living water.

Then ask:

- Do you see that you can only be fully satisfied in knowing God?
- Do you understand that you are under God's wrath because you have turned from Him?
- Do you see that Jesus died to pay for your sins and bring you to God?
- Are you ready to repent and trust Jesus to save, direct, and satisfy you?

If he agrees with the above, lead him in prayer through each point.
